A finalist in the South Australian Champion of Champions on several occasions, in 2002 he won the male section of the Victorian Champion of Champions. Other 2004 highlights included a performance in the South Australian Showcase and appearing as a support act to Troy Cassar-Daly at the 'Beachport Festival by the Sea'.

After winning 2nd place in the Adelaide Hills Idol in 2005 he took some time out to record his debut album 'Memory Lane', truly showcasing his song writing ability and his fine musicianship.

Malcolm Potts performs with his bass guitar and has a unique ability to shape the music, creating a fullness to the sound of the band. He has performed in many large venues including the Festival Theatre in Adelaide.

Ben Furnell has also been a solo performer, winning many awards in country festivals, including Male Vocal, Duet and Country Rock. In Outback Overdrive he is an essential part of the band, providing not only great harmonies but creating a strong acoustic rhythm.

Tony Rose has been playing drums for over thirty years in many genres of music – including country, rock, swing and jazz. He has played most major venues in South Australia and in bands billed as supporting acts for international bands such as "The Searchers' and 'The Bachelors'. It's just as well, because we all know a band is nothing without a great drummer!
