# Conditions



1. Site applications and payment must be in the hands of the Secretary, no later than 1/2/2020. If an application is cancelled after closing date a 10% administration fee will be retained. No refunds if cancelled after 10th February.
2. The Committee of The Karoonda Farm Fair shall have the power to enter upon the area on which the field days are being conducted at any time and remove any articles, signs, pictures, or printed matter which in their opinion may be a cause of offense to the public or the officials of the committee or which the committee deems inappropriate.
3. Booked sites are clearly marked and must remain in their allotted boundaries.
4. The Committee shall not be liable for any loss or damage to the exhibitor's property while on the oval complex..
5. The sites are available from 9.00 a.m. Wednesday.
6. The site must be cleared and left in the same condition as found.
7. **Security.** The Karoonda Farm Fair will provide security on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday nights but shall not be held liable for loss or damage to the exhibitor's property whilst on the field days site.
8. The Farm Fair Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry that is not in the general interest of the Karoonda Farm Fair.
9. The Fair commences at 9.00 a.m. Friday and all vehicles must be removed from the oval at that time.
10. **Exhibitors must before digging any holes or driving any objects into the ground, seek permission from the site manager to ensure that there are no underground power cables or water pipes which could be damaged or cause injury to the exhibitor or his staff. All damages caused by exhibitors or their staff will be repaired at exhibitors' expense.**
11. The use of amplifiers and loud speakers is strictly prohibited unless otherwise arranged with the committee. No amplifiers or loud speakers to be used at indoor sites.
12. No exhibitor shall conduct or permit a raffle to be conducted in the area of the field days without prior written consent from The Karoonda Farm Fair.
13. No exhibitor may sell food without prior approval of Committee.
14. Exhibitors shall conform with the requirements of any Act of Parliament which may govern the erection of structures, the display and/or other products or goods of the exhibitors, and the regulation by-laws and ordinances made under such an Act.
15. In the event that it should be found necessary or expedient to cancel or postpone the said field days a notice of such cancellation or postponement will be published at the earliest practicable time subsequent upon such cancellation or postponement and The Karoonda Farm Fair shall not be liable to any exhibitor for any compensation whether on the ground of loss of profits or otherwise in respect of such cancellation or postponement and the exhibitor shall not be entitled to any refund or payment of any money paid by the exhibitor in relation to the said field days.
16. All electrical leads, appliances and equipment used on site are to be suitably Tested, Tagged and Dated to ensure compliance with current electrical safety standards.
17. Exhibitors must ensure that all equipment, as well as their activities are fully compliant with all current Occupational Health and Safety (OH&S) Standards, Rules and Legislative requirements during their attendance at the event.
