



Section S – Scarecrow Competition

General Information

This competition aims to highlight the important role of the scarecrow.

- Scarecrows must be able to scare off birds, predators etc. by way of material being upright, shiny and their movement with the wind.
- Entries will be judged on their function, appeal, and originality.
- Novelty scarecrows can be any shape, character, animal, or thing, but remember the aim of the scarecrow.
- Scarecrows will be displayed in the open and need to withstand the elements.
- Scarecrows must have a centre stick or cross bar to be displayed.
- All scarecrows are all to be under 1.7meters high.
- All exhibits are entered at own risk. Overnight protection is not provided.
- All exhibits must be accompanied with an exhibit ticket.

1. Storybook, cartoon, movie, or TV character scarecrow
2. Traditional looking scarecrow
