All Fleeces will be tested by Classings P/L Murray Bridge. All wool to be weighed by convener.

All fleeces will be judged on commercial value by independent qualified wool experts.

Fleeces in each category 6-14 can be from an Ewe, Hogget or a Wether (Rams fleeces must be entered into the Keller Livestock Stud Section)

Please Note entries in Classes 6-14 may be re classified after all commercial fleeces are wool tested. Entrants will be notified of any changes.
